Youth meet downstairs in the Youth Room and the rest of the classes are upstairs. For the service, clipboards are available from the Greeters in the foyer for older kids to take sermon notes. There is also a nursery upstairs (Classroom 2) and quiet room inside it with a window & speakers to hear the sermon for those who need to take care of their baby's needs or have a toddler under 4 who isn't yet able to sit through a whole service.

You need a Bible: We believe that it is important for you to be able to test and see for yourself what is being taught from the Word of God. Our pastors teach from the English Standard Version. Bibles are available free of charge at the Welcome Centre. They are our gift to you!

Nominee Recommendations Office of Deacon

The process for calling them begins with their names and contact information being posted in the church bulletin for a period of three (3) consecutive Sundays beginning March 22nd. During the 3 calendar weeks, as part of the R.H. church family, **you are encouraged to speak personally with John and Greg** in order to get to know them. Also, if you are aware of any disqualifying characteristics for either of them, (*Titus 1 & 1 Timothy 3*), you are to address the issue personally with him as per *Matthew 18*. If the matter remains unresolved, either the nominee or the church family member should approach Rod Dueck or Pastor Aidan. If it still remains unresolved, his name will be removed from consideration. If nothing comes up and the 3 weeks pass, both of these men will begin as Deacons on the 4th Sunday (April 12th). John Gonzalez:

I grew up in a Catholic family. We attended church out of tradition, not conviction. When I was 19 or 20, a friend invited me to a Christian camp. There, I met the Lord. In my first prayer to Him, I asked for forgiveness for my sins, like idolatry, even though I didn't realise I had many more. I started attending church and learned more about the Bible. My convictions weren't very strong, and I drifted away. Being in the world, my sins led me to make many mistakes. It was then that the Lord showed me His grace and mercy, breaking my vain plans and breaking my heart to bring me back to Him. I looked for a Spanish-speaking church, which I found in Saskatoon. I attended as often as I could, despite the distance. I decided to move to Saskatoon, but some things weren't quite right. They went well and I returned to Swift Current. Now I understand that the Lord wanted me here. In prayer, I asked the Lord to guide me to a local church, and that's how I came to Restoration House. The Lord has been working in my life for several years now, strengthening me in love for Him, my convictions (faith), and knowledge of His word.

I was raised on the family farm outside of Cabri where I live now with my wife Nancy. We have 3 grown sons, all married, and 5 grandchildren.

Growing up we only went to church at Christmas and Easter. My wife and mother-in-law helped lead me to a personal walk with Jesus.
