For one-time or automatic monthly donations via credit card or bank account, head to restorationhousesc.org/give and choose the PayPal option.

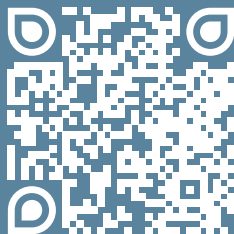
