RH Kidz: Children are important to us! Families are encouraged to attend Sunday School at 9am every week. There are classes for everyone ages 3+. Youth meet downstairs in the Youth Room and the rest of the classes are upstairs. For the service, clipboards are available from the Greeters in the foyer for older kids to take sermon notes. There is also a nursery upstairs (Classroom 2) and quiet room inside it with a window & speakers to hear the sermon for those who need to take care of their baby's needs or have a toddler under 4 who isn't yet able to sit through a whole service.
