- 5. Why did God deserve the glory over Nebuchadnezzar?
- 6. **Read Matthew 23:1-12.**
- 7. What is Jesus' complaint against these scribes and Pharisees?
- 8. Why are those things a problem?
- 9. What is Jesus' main point in these verses?
- 10. Read Philippians 2:1-11
- 11. How is Christ an example of humility?
- 12. What does it mean to walk in humility?
- 13. Why is humility important in a church?
- 14. What are some ways we can practically live out Philippians 2:3-4?
- 15. Are there times in your life when you glorify yourself instead of God? What steps can you take to aid in preventing self-glorification?

Spend time praying for each other- that an opportunity would arise to share the Gospel and that they would have the boldness to share their faith.
